



PARTICIPANT SAFETY GUIDELINES & AGREEMENT

A Gift For Teaching (AGFT) is excited to welcome your participation in the second annual community giveback project: **The Great Big Backpack Build**. This initiative will help provide relief for local families and teachers at the beginning of next school year by outfitting students with a backpack and school supplies to safely call their own, at no cost.

Please see below for safety precautions for participants to review & sign prior to your build shift. Under the guidance of local, state, and federal health authorities, the wellness and safety of our students, teachers, and community continues to be a priority of AGFT. In taking all necessary precautions, **all participants must adhere to the following:**

Prior to your team's build shift, participants;

- Are asked to **stay home if:** they are sick, have personally or been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days prior to their shift, or have pre-existing conditions that would put them at high-risk, even if they are fully vaccinated.
- Are expected to adhere to social distancing guidelines, remaining 3-6 ft. apart from others (per Orange County guidelines), and general health safety measures (coughing/sneezing into the elbow, washing hands frequently, avoid touching the face, etc.) while at AGFT
- Be prepared to follow a no handshake/hugging policy at AGFT

Prior to entering the building, participants;

- **Must have a well-fitting face mask on** – masks will be provided outside for those that do not have one
- Are asked to have the 2-sided volunteer waiver already completed; please email back to us or bring with them
- Are asked to monitor their temperature prior to arrival and remain home if temperature is 100.4 or higher

Upon entering the building:

- Participants will be asked to sanitize their hands; AGFT will have gloves for those who also wish to wear them
- Participants' temperatures will be taken by an AGFT representative. If temperature is 100.4 or higher, participant will not be allowed in the building and asked to return home.
- Participants will be given an overview of safety policies by AGFT staff prior to the start of the build shift

AGFT will be taking the following safety measures as well:

- All public surfaces will be sanitized prior to participants entering the building
- Provide hand sanitizer at the front door and throughout the building
- Each shift will have no more than 35 participants, plus AGFT event team, in our 5,000 sq. ft. event space
- Each backpack-building station will be at least 10ft apart

I affirm that I meet the health standards and will abide by the guidelines identified above. I agree that should I become ill or show symptoms that could be related to COVID-19, I will inform AGFT of my symptoms or illness, leave the site immediately, and not return until I am symptom free for 14 days.
